Day 1: Arrive in Yinchuan

Welcome to Yinchuan! Upon arrival at Hedong International Airport, you will be greeted and transferred to your hotel in downtown Yinchuan. Relax and settle in after your journey, preparing for an exciting adventure.

There are many mosques in Ningxia Hui Autonomous Region because most Hui people are Islamic. We will have a car tour of the **Nanguan Mosque**, a famous mosque among thousands of mosques in Ningxia, & have a photo-taking session outside the mosque.

Day 2: Yinchuan Cultural Exploration

Explore the Western Xia Mausoleum National Archaeological Site Park, often called the "Pyramids of China," to uncover the history of the Western Xia Dynasty. Visit the Zhenbeibu Western Film Studio, a famous filming location for Chinese movies, and admire ancient petroglyphs at Helan Mountain Rock Paintings. End your day at the bustling Ningxia Huaiyuan Night Market, sampling local delicacies.

Day 3: Yinchuan to Alxa Left Banner

Begin the day at the **Sanguankou Ming Great Wall Ruins** before heading to **Ulaan Lake Five Lakes Crossing** in Alxa Left Banner, where you'll enjoy stunning desert and lake landscapes, complemented by an off-road vehicle tour. In the evening, experience a lively bonfire party at **Tonghu Grassland** before staying overnight in Zhongwei.



Day 4: Zhongwei Adventures

On the fourth day, we will visit **Shapotou Scenic Area**, where the desert meets an oasis, offering activities like camel riding and sand sliding. Then, marvel at the red sandstone formations of **Huoshizhai** (**Firestone Ridge**), a Danxia landform unique to China. Enjoy an authentic farm-to-table dinner in **Xiji** and stay overnight.

Day 5: Xiji to Wuzhong

Explore the Yellow River Stone Forest, a stunning geopark combining stone formations and river views. Visit the historic **Dong Mansion (Dongfu)**, known for its traditional Chinese architecture, before heading to **Wuzhong** to savour Ningxia specialties and rest overnight.

Day 6: Cultural Immersion in Wuzhong and Yinchuan

Immerse yourself in Hui ethnic traditions, culture and lifestyle at the **Wuzhong Muslim Cultural Village**, where you'll learn to make fried pastries and brew Eight Treasures Tea. Discover Ningxia's rich history at the **Ningxia Museum** and enjoy panoramic views from **Lanshan Park** in Yinchuan.

Day 7: Natural Wonders of Yinchuan

Visit **Sand Lake Scenic Area**, where the desert meets water, offering boat rides and bird-watching opportunities. Learn about Ningxia's signature superfood at the **Goji Berry Museum** and wrap up the day with a visit to the historic **Drum Tower** in downtown Yinchuan.

Day 8: Yinchuan – Home Sweet Home

After enjoying a pleasant breakfast, our trip will end, and we will transfer you to Yinchuan Hedong Airport for the corresponding flight.

Travel Tips for Ningxia

- 1. Prepare for the Climate: In China's northwest, Ningxia has a temperate continental climate, featuring long sunshine hours and intense UV rays. Guests should bring essentials like a water bottle, sunglasses, sun hat, high-SPF sunscreen, and a sunshade fan for protection. It's also recommended that some essential medications be packed for personal use.
- 2. Temperature Range: Summer temperatures in Ningxia typically range from 15°C to 35°C, with significant variations between day and night. Consider bringing warmer clothing to layer up when temperatures drop, even in summer.
- 3. When travelling to Ningxia in winter, because Ningxia is in the northwest of China, the climate is relatively dry, and the temperature difference between day and night is large, so it is necessary to prepare clothes suitable for low temperatures and dry environments.
- 4. Stay Hydrated: Ningxia's dry climate requires frequent hydration and replenishing salts and vitamins to maintain good health. Drink plenty of water during hot days to stay calm and prevent heat exhaustion.



- 5. Local Culture and Cuisine: Ningxia is home to a diverse population with unique cultural customs. The local cuisine mainly features beef and lamb, reflecting the regional dietary habits of the Hui people and other ethnic communities.
- 6. Fruit Paradise: Known for its abundant produce, Ningxia offers a wealth of fresh fruits during summer. Make the most of this by enjoying the delicious local varieties!
- 7. Desert Adventure Tips: A camel ride in the desert offers a unique way to unwind and experience a thrilling adventure, but it's essential to keep in mind a few safety tips:
 - Stick with the Group: Desert travel is best done with a group. Stay together and support one another for a safer and more enjoyable experience.
 - Sun Protection: If visiting between June and October, wear sunscreen and light-coloured, UV-protective clothing.
 - Protect Your Devices: Desert sand can be delicate and pervasive, so handle cameras, phones, and other devices carefully.
 - Camel Riding: When the camel stands or kneels, hold onto the saddle or hump to avoid falls. Relax with the camel's movement and adjust your posture for a smoother ride.
- 8. Yellow River Rafting Tips: Remember these safety measures for rafting on the Yellow River using traditional sheepskin rafts.
 - Boarding: Step onto the raft slowly and steadily, placing your foot across multiple wooden bars to avoid missteps.
 - Sit Carefully: Avoid sudden movements when sitting. Remain seated and avoid standing or roughhousing during the trip.
 - Wear Life Vests: Always wear a life vest; if large waves appear, hold onto the bars and stay seated.
 - Plan for Longer Distances: The vast northwest region of China involves longer drives between scenic spots, so pace your travel activities and get sufficient rest. Wear comfortable, breathable shoes to make your trip smoother and more enjoyable.
